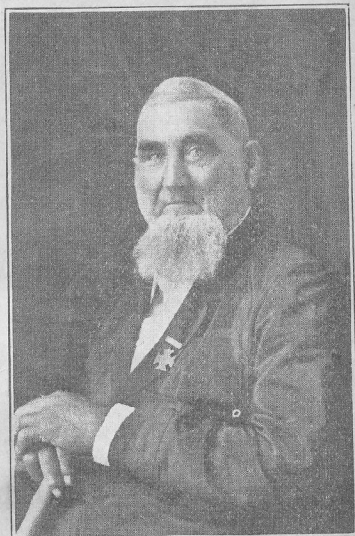

## THE PASSING OF A VETERAN.

Father of Brother Marvin C. Hill, 30°. Confederate Veteran and for nearly sixty years a member of the Masonic fraternity and of the Methodist Church, dies at his home in Lockhart. Grand Junior Warden A. A. Ross conducts funeral ceremony.

Brother Edward Peyton Hill, one of the oldest and most loved Masons in this section of the State, passed to this section of the "great Beyond" at his home in Lockhart on Sunday January 16, 1916, and the remains were laid to rest in Cedar Fork cemetery near that city the following day, in the presence of a large concourse of friends and relatives. The funeral ceremonies were conducted under the auspices of Lockhart Lodge No. 690, A. F. & A. M., of which the deceased was a member; R. W. Alonzo A. Ross, 32°, Grand Junior Warden of the Grand Lodge of Texas, officiating.

Brother Hill was born in the State of Mississippi in 1833, and came to Texas at the age of 23, locating in Travis County, near Bluff Springs. At the age of 28 he became a member of Onion Creek Lodge No. 220, A. F. & A. M. At the outbreak of the Civil war he enlisted in the famous Hood's brigade, serving there until the close of the war. From 1860 until his death he was a devoted member of the Methodist church and the most significant of the many tributes that were paid to his life and character as a Christian, a citizen and a Mason; was the presence at the funeral of a Baptist, a Methodist and a Christian minister, all of whom read the burial rites of their respective churches.

## The pallbearers were:

Honorary—Dr. A. A. Ross, of Lockhart; Dr. T. B. Coopwood, of Lockhart; Uncle Wiley Carpenter, of Lockhart; C. E. McDaniel, of Lockhart; R. Jacobs, of Luling; Dr. W. H. O'Banion, of Lockhart.

Active—H. L. King, of Luling; A. R. Chew, Will Blackwell, A. E. Carter, Martin Callahan and Sid Grigsby of Lockhart.

Surviving are four sons and one daughter residing in Lockhart; two sons residing in Temple and three sons residing in San Antonio. To them we extend our heartfelt sympathy in this hour of sorrow.

The Shriners ball which was held in the Cathedral on Friday, January 21, was a great success. Much credit is due to the arrangement committee, headed by Noble Edw. McClannahan. The grand march was headed by Noble Soule and wife, followed by San Antonio Patrol, in full uniform.





# Twigs and Trees \* \* \* Hill Family Ancestor Was Cromwell Supporter

In our quest for Hill family data, Mrs. Eva Hill Aert of San Antonio has kindly contributed the following letter, dated 1890, written in Webberville, Texas:

"Dear Cousin: Your very welcome letter of the 1st inst. came to hand in due time and I will answer very promptly. You asked some questions about your Hill relations which I will give so far as is in my power, and first there is nothing in the history of the original family which the younger members need be ashamed.

"We are of an old English stock, of which Roland Hill (a Baptist preacher in days of Cromwell of England, was a sworn supporter of Cromwell in his reign), was a principal representative. The younger Cromwell failed and the sons of Roland Hill failed with him and two James and Samuel, I think? were their names, were imprisoned for treason. The younger son Isaac was a boy of fourteen at the time and is given credit for releasing them from prison and securing their safety to America in its early settlement. They came and brought with them their unconquerable love of religious liberty which cost them much trouble here as this country was in the hands of high churchmen, and one of them being a Baptist preacher and preached his doctrine freely suffered many severe persecutions in this country.

"The youngest son Isaac is the one from which we are the direct descendants. When he left England, his father Roland, gave him a purse in which he put some coins and this purse, or puzzle, into which no one could go without being taught the way, was given to Isaac's son, unless he died without children, then it was to go to the youngest brother, etc.

"Isaac's son was grandfather Thom Hill's father, I think, or his grandfather, named Jonathan. Our grandfather was his youngest son. James and William were both younger than him but he died young and it came into William's right, your father was his youngest son and the purse was his by rights, unless he died without children.

"Grandfather . . . married Miss Mary Tillery, who had four sons and four daughters . . . son of doctor Ira Hill died in Tennessee, leaving several children.

"I've never been able to get in touch with any of them. He was an educated

physician and a genuine gentleman. I remember him well. The second son, Tillery Hill was my father and received the family name of Mother Tillery. He married Sarah Hill, my mother, who had four children: Lafayette Decatur, my own name, and the oldest named by my grandfather Thom Hill. Sarah Elizabeth, the oldest girl, named by Grandmother Hill for Grandmother Rector, Sarah and Aunt Betty Hill. Francis Manon, the second son, and Mary Jane, the youngest child, named for Grandmother Hill and Aunt Jane Egnew or Hill. The third son, Runy died young but had a wife, and I think one child, but I know nothing of them. The fourth youngest son was your father Oliver Hazard Perry. Your father's sisters were Ann, the oldest girl who was Perry Walker's mother, and I know nothing of any of the rest of her children, she married a second time. I never knew who.

"Elizabeth married Andy Kincannon, they moved from Tennessee, I never knew to where. Jane, the third girl married Sam Egnew and raised a large family. They moved from Tennessee to Missouri where Aunt Jane died.

Uncle Sam was alive a few years since in Ozark, Missouri. Aunt Jane had a widowed daughter Alvera A. Chapman living in Ozark, Missouri that I corresponded with.

"I was fifty-two the 10th of last January.

"Your father's youngest sister married a man named Murphy in Tennessee, she had one child by Murphy, both are dead, then she married a man named Smith, had one daughter by him, who is now married and lives in Texas. As this is a genealogical letter I will give you a list of the family. I married Sarah Ann Dury June 1855, we have three children: Mary, who first married Dr. W. V. Kencaster, by whom she had two sons: Willie who died when cutting teeth, and Henry Vance who lives with her. Mary then married E. E. Winfrey by whom she had one son John Phillip. Joe Thompson, our son was twenty-two the second of this month, married Leora Hunter, they call their son Hunter. Franklin Marion, our youngest son is living with us. Joe lives one and one half miles from us on the Winfrey's farm. He is farming and

doing well.

"Leora belongs to the Baptist Church, the others to the Methodist. Write to me and let me hear from the family. Your cousin, L. D. Hill (or Lafayette Decatur) Hill.

"Recapitulation:

"Your father's sisters: Ann, married Walker; Betsy married Kincannon;

Jane married Sam Egnew. Margaret married Murphy and Smith. Dr. Thom Hill's brothers: Samuel settled in Illinois; Jonathan in Missouri; James and William died in Tennessee. Your father's brothers and self: Ira, the oldest died in Tennessee; Tillery died in Tenn.; Runy died in Tenn.; D.M.P. died in Texas."
