Member of NASA's 1st Lunar landing team.

Robert "Bob" Thomas Weir, age 82 of Ingram, Texas, died peacefully on Friday, Sept. 24, 2010.

Bob was born in San Antonio to Charles and Mary Rita (Portland) Weir on Dec. 7, 1928.

Bob worked at Boeing on projects for NASA. Bob was always proud of the contributions he made to the space program.

In later years Bob sold real estate. Bob was an avid reader and collected coins and stamps, and he enjoyed using the metal detector to look for treasures.

Bob married Joyce Neill Shepperd on November 14, 1961. Bob and Joyce had many exciting adventures making trips to Mexico and throughout the United States.
